Upgrading Students

- High School Graduates, age 19 or less on Sept 1
- \$100 Book Deposit, refundable when books returned by June 25, 2020

Adults

- Age 20 or older as of Sept. 1
- \$100 Registration Fee, plus \$120 per credit

We accept cash, cheque, debit & credit cards. Payments can also be made online using the *PowerSchool Parent Portal* that is on our website (under Students/Parents tab). You will need the student's Alberta Student Number (ASN) to login.

Attendance & Course Completion

The most successful students at Didsbury Career High School attend on a regular basis and a minimum of twice a week. Talk to a staff member to schedule manageable deadlines to achieve your academic goals for each term.

Alberta Education requires us to track every student's attendance so we need students to sign in and out at the front desk. If you have made arrangements to work away from school, be sure to contact the school. If no work is handed in within a 60 day period, you will be withdrawn.

Assignments & Marks

After assignments are handed in, they are marked and then filed by last name. These marked assignments can be taken out and looked over, but must stay at the school. If you need your completed assignments to study for an exam, please make the necessary arrangements with a teacher.

Parents and students can see marks for individual assignments and tests, or final course marks in *PowerSchool*. Completed course marks will be under "dropped courses" and can only be seen on the full version of *PowerSchool* (not the app). Students and parents have separate accounts.

School Messenger

Chinook's Edge School Division uses *School Messenger* to send out mass emails or texts to parents or students in case of an emergency or school updates. It is important that *School Messenger* has two family member's cell numbers for receiving texts and two email addresses that are checked regularly. To receive text messages, you will need to "opt in" by sending **Y** or **Yes** to **724665**. This information can be added or edited in the *PowerSchool*.
